

Audit of Washinton County Schools Finds Former Superintendent Misspent Funds

RALEIGH, (SGRToday.com) - An audit of Washington County Schools spending has uncovered misspent funds by the former superintendent, as well as other items related to unauthorized spending.

State Auditor Beth Wood's office released the audit Tuesday, with this summary:

"Investigators determined the former Superintendent, Board Members, and Administrative employees spent approximately \$134,000 without prior written authorization, a documented business purpose, or expenditure receipts. In addition, the former Superintendent misspent \$15,800 of federal funds on entertainment."
