

IG: VA Cybersecurity Effort Doesn't Pass Muster...Again

RALEIGH, (SGRToday.com) - Veterans Administration officials are bracing for a new Inspector General report that will call out the agency for poor cybersecurity, according to Federalnewsradio.com. It will be the 16th year the agency's efforts have fallen short of expectations.

Last week Veterans Administration officials got word of the results, even though the full report isn't expect to be published until 2015.

Last year the watchdog audit pointed out thousands of problems with cybersecurity and made three dozen recommendations for closing the holes.

Federalnewsradio.com reports agency officials are prepared to counter the new audit by saying they've acted on about half of the 2013 recommendations.
