

FBI To Double Background Check Examiners To Enforce President's Gun Control Executive Actions

RALEIGH, (SGRToday.com) - The federal workforce will grow under President Obama's executive actions to tighten the rules on who can sell and own firearms.

A White House fact sheet notes that the FBI "will hire more than 230 additional examiners and other staff to help process these background checks."
