

2014 Visitor Spending Climbs In All But 3 North Carolina Counties

RALEIGH, (SGRToday.com) - North Carolina continues to be a destination of choice for vacationers. Data shows that in 2014, domestic visitor spending jumped to a record \$21.3 billion, with 97 counties showing gains.

Only Davie, Granville and Swain counties had lower spending levels.
