Daughtridge was appointed Secretary of Administration in 2013. A former three-term member of the North Carolina House of Representatives,

Daughtridge brought to the Administration department extensive leadership experience gained in the private, public and non-profit community service sectors.

At the Industrial Commission, Daughtridge will be one of six commissioners responsible for administrating the Workers' Compensation Act, the Tort Claims Act, the Childhood Vaccine-Related Injury Act, the Law Enforcement Officers', Firemen's, Rescue Squad Workers', and Civil Air Patrol Members' Death Benefit Act, the Act to Compensate Individuals Erroneously Convicted of Felonies, and the Eugenics Compensation Program.
