Border Dispute Between The Carolinas Has Beem Settled

Governor Pat McCrory signed an Executive Order that officially re-establishes the boundary line between the state of North Carolina and South Carolina from Polk to Brunswick County.

" This Executive Order is a culmination of more than 20 years of work from leaders in North and South Carolina, " said Governor McCrory

. "I am proud of our efforts to settle this issue and our strong partnership with Governor Nikki Haley and our neighbors in South Carolina. "

Efforts to clarify the boundary between North and South Carolina began in 1994, and in May 2013, the Joint North Carolina/South Carolina Boundary Commission completed its work to settle the boundary line. In June 2016, Governor McCrory

signed legislation re-establishing the border which goes into effect on January 1, 2017. The bill addressed tax, education and property concerns for several impacted property owners.
