Civitas Senate Poll: Hagan 41, Tillis 40, Haugh 4

RALEIGH, (SGRToday.com) - A new poll of registered voters in North Carolina shows a very tight race for the U.S. Senate seat now held by Democrat Kay Hagan.

The Civitas Institute poll conducted by National Research Inc., shows Hagan with 41 percent of the vote and her Republican challenger, N.C. House Speaker Thom Tillis, just one point behind at 40 percent.

Libertarian Sean Haugh draws 4 percent of registered voters.

When voters were asked to choose only between Hagan and Tillis, Hagan continued to lead, 43 to 42 percent.
