Woodhouse formerly led the North Carolina chapter of Americans for Prosperity and is currently head of Carolina Rising. He is known for being a dogged and outspoken defender of conservative policies.

Woodhouse begins his tenure at a key time for Republicans: a presidential election year. Gov

McCrory

is up for re-election, as is Sen. Richard Burr. All U.S

. congressional seats and all General Assembly seats will also be on the November 2016 ballot.

North Carolina's primaries have been moved up from May to March 15.
